

**Town of Inola Regular Board of Trustees Meeting

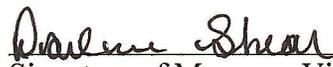
MAYOR'S COMMENTS:

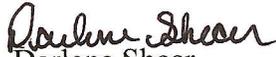
